Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - There are 4 sizings of hook type fork carriages rated by the blade carriage lifting capacity. Hook type fork carriages have been uniform.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type tines could be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades may differ by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
